Remember you need a pass to be able to come in at lunch. Collect your pass from Mrs Fazackerley in the library the morning of your allocated day.





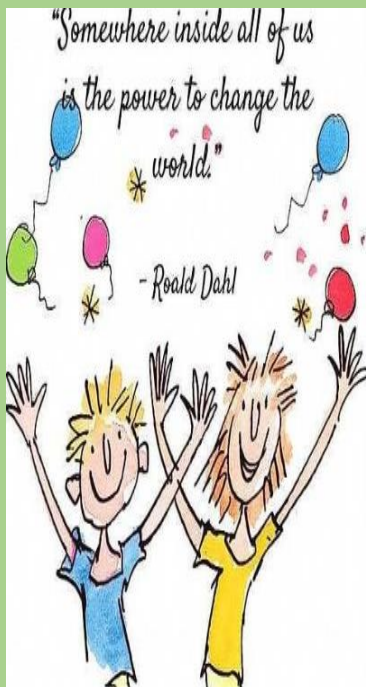
