

Year 7 History Homework Menu Term 2

Choose something from this menu each fortnight to complete for your History homework. There are more options here than you need to do so that you have some choice. By Easter you should have completed 6 home works. Students with a target level of 1 or below can choose any of the options, those with a target level of 2 must choose at least one option from the top row and those with a target level of 3 or above must choose two of the options on the top row.

Write a newspaper article about the death of William the Conqueror.

Research the information from the internet about his death, funeral and major events of his life.

Create a Medieval first aid kit or write a first aid manual for medieval diseases including the Black Death (the plague).

Write a report about the Black Death (the plague) for the Government of the time. What did people think caused it?,

How did it affect people?
How was it going to affect the country?

Design a board game to teach other students about Medieval life. You do not have to make the game, but show how it would look, the instructions and rules, ideas for counters etc.

Research & draw the family tree of the Yorkist family, or draw your own family tree. How far back can you go?

Imagine time-travelling has been invented, allowing tourists to travel back in time. Write a guide book for tourists on what to expect from Medieval England. Include: travel, entertainment, customs etc

Re-write a well known nursery rhyme so that it is about the Black Death.
You can not use 'Ring a ring a roses'
Can you explain why not?

Create a rap about the formation of the Tudor Rose. Research where it came from, why it is like it is and include this in your rap.

Write a song (2 verses and a chorus) about the life of either a Medieval Peasants year in the country side, or a worker in a Medieval town and their daily life.

Create a visual display showing how the feudal system worked.

Research the Battle of Bosworth. Create a puzzle or quiz about the Battle.
