YOU NEED TO THINK ABOUT:

- ✓ Make notes about their work explaining your thoughts and opinions.
- ✓ Produce work using similar styles or themes to the artists' work you have looked at.
- ✓ Annotate to explain your ideas, the links with your work and your understanding of the artists work.

- ✓ Draw from first hand resources in a variety of techniques.
- ✓ Take photographs which explore your starting point. Aim to use these photographs in further studies, drawings, paintings or designs for 3D work.
- ✓ Annotate your work to communicate your ideas and intentions.

- ✓ Use lots of different techniques and experiment!
- ✓ Improve ideas by reflecting on experiments.
- ✓ Repeat drawings, rearrange compositions, test different colours, join different experiments together.
- ✓ Try new ideas, even if they don't work, reflect and learn from these.
- ✓ Practise with the media you aim to use for your final piece.
- ✓ Annotate your ideas, what have you done why and who is it in the style of?

- ✓ You should plan your ideas for your final piece carefully.
- ✓ You should practice different materials and techniques towards your final piece..
- ✓ This work should show that you have linked it to the starting point and it must show links with the artists, images and techniques you have explored in your prep work.
