

BTEC Music Learning Journey

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Learners will be given the opportunity to develop and present music in response to a given music brief. During the component students will have to use the knowledge and skills gain in both component 1 and component 2 . This will include awareness of a variety of musical styles, whilst demonstrating independent musicianship.

Performing stylistically accurate cover versions.
Composing original music using existing stylistic frameworks and traits.
Stylistic use of a DAW and associated hardware to create an original piece of music from a given starting point.

Learners will explore professional techniques for musicians and look at how musicians share their music with others. They will learn to use a variety of methods of evidencing processes and outcomes and communicating skills development.

2. Creating original music
3. Music production.

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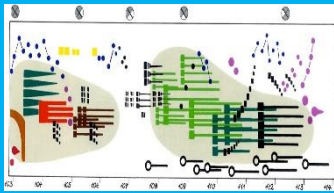
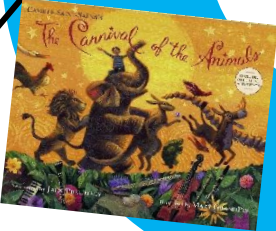
